The industrial heritage of Rijeka

Rijeka is a city with an industrial past, from the 18th century city grows with industry, industrial buildings, warehouses. Manufactures and industrial production of paper started near river Rječina in eastern part of the city, the first port of Rijeka. In the west part, the first production was planned near sea coast. Oil refinery, sugar refinery, rope factory, paper factory, tanneries, torpedo factory, shipyards, foundries and other kinds of productions were built in former peripheral industrial zones. The development of the production was followed by building roads, railways, and new modern port. In the 20th Century, in the socialist period after the Second World War industrial production carries the rebuilding of the city and its development. Today, the abandoned architectural heritage which are today a part of the city center, during an almost 300 year-long industrial history witnesses the city development that was stopped in the 1990s after a period of privatization.

Research on the industrial heritage of Rijeka, both tangible and intangible, has been ongoing for 15 years emphasizing the importance of all aspects of heritage, architecture, history, naval heritage and the intangible heritage that is most difficult to preserve.

The lecture will cover industrial history themes of the city and connection of development of the city with the development of the Koper and Trieste.



Kristina Pandža, MSc in History and Informatics, employed at the Centre for Industrial Heritage at the University of Rijeka and working on project Touristic valorization of representative monuments of Rijeka industrial heritage as Expert Associate, Project Coordinator, and Researcher. Works on historical and archive research on topics related to the industrial history of Rijeka in the 20th Century and history of ship Seagull for future museum's permanent exhibition. Till now has worked as researcher on several project based on cultural and industrial heritage: researching, digitalization, promoting it in tourism: Project Digitalization of industrial heritage of Rijeka, in cooperation with Department for culture City of Rijeka, Project Pitaj, ne skitaj, digitalization cultural heritage of City of Krk; Project Visit Krk, digitalization of cultural heritage of island of Krk; Project Mapping of industrial heritage of Primorje - Gorski kotar County.
